**25 MON Northern Africa**  
God has added three new local workers to the small team in northern Africa. This is an encouragement to them as they labor in an area where opposition is strong. This doesn't stop the team from sharing the gospel with joy and courage. Pray for God's protection on the team.

**26 TUE Second Attempt**  
A GRN Nepal team is making a second attempt to record the Olangchung Gola language after they were hindered the first time. The Olangchung Gola is a Buddhist group. Pray for good recordings to be made and for many to be led into repentance and faith.

**27 WED The Angku of China**  
The Angku of China is an unreached and unengaged people group with no Christian witness. Ask God to lead a GRN team to visit the Angku and record the gospel for them. Pray that the Spirit will prepare hearts to respond to the good news.

**28 THU The Tunni of Somalia**  
The Tunni people of Somalia follow the Muslim religion. Their country is in turmoil and dangerous to outsiders. Ask God to open the way for a GRN team to deliver the good news to the Tunni.

**29 FRI Muslim Work**  
Pray for the Lord of the harvest to flood the fields in Muslim lands with greater numbers of bold workers.

**30 SAT Kevin and Ruth Horan**  
Pray for Kevin as he leads the USA IT department. Pray for wisdom, direction and clear communications with the other departments in the office. Kevin and Ruth are expecting their first baby in October.


**31 SUN 75th Anniversary Celebrations**  
Pray for the events in local churches happening in September: in Eagle Point, Oregon on Sept. 5-7, and in Flagstaff, Arizona on Sept. 20-21. May this be a time to praise God for the last 75 years and a time to share the vision for future ministry.

Dear Friends,

I recently returned from a three-week trip visiting GRN staff in Kenya, Tanzania and India. It was a very beneficial time for me to see the GRN Kenya team in action. I travelled with David Elliott, GRN Canada's Director, and had special times of planning with others for ministry expansion in Tanzania under the leadership of GRN Kenya. We were blessed by seeing the joy brought by presenting a new language recording in Ateso to distribute in the Teso Land of Kenya and Uganda, in a six-hour dedication. And I will never forget speaking to high school students at a rural Kenyan public school, challenging them to consider God's calling to be missionaries to their home country and around the world.

One of the greatest impressions of my trip to Africa was seeing the devotion, and struggle, of GRN staff. They labor in ways in which I, as an American, cannot fully appreciate. Electricity cut off in the middle of a nighttime meal, or more difficult, in the middle of a language recording. Nightmarish traffic and government red tape. Taking a full day to pay a utility bill. Add to that terrorism (while we were in Kenya, 60 men were murdered on the coast), low pay, and often humble living conditions, and you are left with a devoted team anxious to share the story of Jesus in every language. Please remember the needs of these brothers and sisters in prayer.

The distribution team that provided recordings for visitors in Washington DC over the July 4th holiday gave out thousands of CDs in over 100 languages. Pray that the messages continue to speak to hearts about Jesus.

Thank the Lord for Keith and Lois Larson who have served with GRN USA for 12 years. Keith recently retired from the IT department and is looking for the Lord's direction for their future. Pray for Keith and Lois and God's guidance for them.

**8 FRI** **Distribution**  
Pray for GRN Centers in Western countries encountering a growing Islamic presence. The fear of terrorism and prejudice has grown in many places. Pray for proactive distribution of GRN materials.

**9 SAT** **Wildlife Storytellers**  
Wildlife Storytellers provide cuddly toy animals for children and women in crisis in the developing world. Each animal is embedded with a mp3 player containing GRN Bible stories in the local language. Pray for widespread use and for Guy and Jan Piersall as they develop an effective promotional program.

**10 SUN** **New Director for Switzerland**  
Philippe Tapernoux has been appointed as national director for GRN Switzerland. He will work with former director Pierre Andre during the transition. Pray for Philippe, and his wife Corinne, as he works out of his home in France.

**11 MON** **Praying for Recordists**  
Dan Rulison, our International Ministries Field Manager, recently gave these prayer requests for recordists. Join with us as we pray for: (1) A close walk with the Lord; (2) Dependence upon Him in every situation; (3) Steadfastness in temptations and trials; (4) God's comfort and help in times of loneliness.

**12 TUE** **Praying for Recordists Continued**  
(5) Good relationships with others - spouses, church leaders, fellow missionaries; (6) Good witness to non-believers; (7) Good health and protection from serious illness; (8) Favor with government officials; (9) Protection over family when traveling.

**13 WED** **Sybil Shaw and Gail Rogne**  
Give praise for a successful recording trip in PNG. Pray for Sybil and Gail as they edit and program these recordings of Acts and Exodus. May the Lord touch the hearts of the people as they listen to the scriptures in their mother tongue.

**14 THU** **On the Field**  
Please pray specifically for these recordists who are out on the front lines: Lok, Swapan, Gracie, Fernanda, Gustavo, Chucho, Barnabas, Boaz and Kish.

**15 FRI** **The Dakpakha of Bhutan**  
The Dakpakha people of Bhutan live in the Himalayas. Virtually all of them are Buddhists with no known Christian witness. Pray for a GRN team to be able to record the good news for them.

**16 SAT** **The Kuan of Laos**  
The Kuan people of Laos have traditionally been animists but now are encountering a growing Buddhist influence. There are no known Christians in this group. God wants them to hear about His Son. Pray that God opens doors for a GRN team to go to the Kuan with the good news.

**17 SUN** **An Open Door**  
In a nation known for harboring terrorists and where several missionaries have been killed, a door is opening for an isolated language to be recorded. A contact person from that nation has agreed to fly to a neutral country to record his language. Pray for provision of a travel visa, for safety throughout the trip, and for effective recordings to be made.

**18 MON** **Short-term Haiti**  
Two of our volunteers, Donna Hughes and Gordon Thies, will travel with a church team ministering in Haiti from August 8 - 18. Pray for opportunities to distribute GRN materials and for prepared hearts to receive the messages.

**19 TUE** **Project India**  
USA Executive Director Dale Rickards traveled to Bangalore in July to meet with the GRN India Board. Project India is making good progress but with the enormity of the task, more prayer, workers and resources are needed.

**20 WED** **Adopting Languages**  
A church in California is considering sponsoring a language in India. They are interested not only in helping fund the recordings but also following through with the language group to see a church planted for them. Pray for these plans.

**21 THU** **Lok's Vision**  
Recordist Lok in NE India has a burden for four specific language groups he would like to reach in the coming months. Pray for good research, contacts, script preparation, and willing language helpers to reach these people with the good news.

**22 FRI** **India - Meyor**  
Pray for Lucky who is preparing to work among the Meyor with the aim of planting the first Meyor church. Pray for him as he prepares to move to the area armed with Saber players, CDs and other GRN tools.

**23 SAT** **International Director in USA**  
Graydon Colville recently traveled from his home in Sydney, Australia, to Houston, Texas, for an International Orality Network conference. After that he visited the GRN USA Mobilization Center in California for a week, meeting with board members and staff.

**24 SUN** **The Sivandi of Iran**  
The Sivandi of Iran is a Muslim group that lives in an area considered closed to the gospel. Nothing is impossible with God so pray for open doors for a GRN team to provide the good news. Pray that even now the Holy Spirit is preparing hearts to respond.
